All the dances were based on Bharatanatyam/Kuchipudi styles. On the one hand the unity of the style across the 10 avatars of Vishnu was beneficial in a seamless program. An alternative would have been to present other styles like Odissi, Kathak, Manipuri for the different avatars to introduce the audience to the diversity of dance that makes up the Indian cultural experience.

A few suggestions

Suggest overall open seating to prevent people switching on their phones in the middle of the concert to find their seats. Saw some people with children bringing food and drink into the auditorium. Suggest people come in during the breaks in the program to prevent having people move to accommodate latecomers during the performance. Limited Parking seemed a problem for the people who arrived closer to the concert time. Suggest an interval if possible. People did take bathroom breaks during the performance. My congratulations and appreciation to APAI and the dance teachers and schools and students for providing a heavenly audience experience!
